

1. The Coffey County Commission met in adjourned session at the Coffey County Courthouse at 9:35 a.m. on Friday, May 12, 2000. Chairman Gene Merry called the meeting to order from Topeka, Kansas via telephone with members Johnnie Sleezer and Perry Powell present. Commissioners Bill Knapp and Tim Sipe were unable to attend due to another appointment. Also present were Vernon Birk, Coffey County Clerk and Election Officer, Coffey County Attorney Doug Witteman, Administrative Coordinator Mary Bloomer and Deputy Election Clerk Jackie Hawley.

2. The Coffey County Commissioners convened as a Canvass Board to canvass the results of the USD #243 Special Bond Election. The County Election Officer presented the original returns together with all other records of the election to the County Board of Canvassers for the purpose of canvass.

3. When only 2 Commissioners were able to be present in the Commission room, it was agreed, after convening, to postpone the canvass until Monday, which is allowed under the Kansas Election Laws.

4. Sleezer moved to recess the canvass until 9:15 a.m. on Monday, May 15, 2000, seconded by Powell. Motion carried.

5. Powell moved to adjourn at approximately 9:45 a.m. until Monday, May 15, 2000, at 9:00 a.m. for the regular scheduled Commission meeting, seconded by Sleezer. Motion carried.
