Chairman Jesse Knight called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with members Tom Hugunin, Don Meats, Tim Johnson and Bob Saueressig present. 5. Knight moved to authorize and direct the Chairman to sign (1) tax abatement in the amount of \$36.82, seconded by Meats. Motion carried.
6. Knight moved to approve Resolution No. 885; A RESOLUTION OF MUTUAL AGREEMENT FOR COUNTYLINE MAINTENANCE, seconded by Johnson. Motion carried.
