

**COVID -19 LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH
EMERGENCY RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, now on this 18th day of May, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County, Kansas, had previously declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, on March 16, 2020, resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Coffey County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions continue to endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Coffey County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Coffey County, Kansas:

That the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas was initially declared on the 16th day of March, 2020, and was to continue and remain in effect for a duration of 60 days unless terminated earlier.

That the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, has remained in effect for the entirety of the 60 days and was not terminated due to the continuing and ongoing state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas.

That the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, has remained in effect for the entirety of the 60 days and in fact, expired at the conclusion of 60 days.

That the state of local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas, continues to remain an ongoing local public health emergency in Coffey County, Kansas and shall continue and remain in effect until July 16, 2020 unless modified or terminated earlier.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Coffey County, Kansas and shall initiate and continue the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law for until July 16, 2020 unless modified or terminated in the manner prescribed by law.

I DO HEREBY INVOKE any and all rights and/or powers to perform such functions as are vested in this office by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act.
