Coffey County Citizens being tested for COVID-19:

**If you get a positive test result and are diagnosed with COVID-19**, please call your close contacts to let them know. Close contacts will need to quarantine (stay away from others) for 10 days from the last time they were around you. They may call our office at 620-364-8631 for further instruction regarding quarantine or any other questions they may have. Household contacts should also quarantine away from you in the household, if possible, as you isolate during your illness.

**If you are tested and the results are expected to take a day or two**, we ask that you personally notify all close contacts which you listed on the back of this form and let them know that you are being tested for COVID-19. It helps us to slow the spread of COVID-19 if you contact them early and ask them to self-quarantine and to keep their distance from others. We also recommend that all household contacts quarantine while waiting for your results. (Depending on the test used, some results take a couple minutes or hours to obtain, while others take 2-3 days.)

If any of your close or household contacts begin to have symptoms of COVID 19, they are encouraged to call their healthcare provider and let them know they were a contact of a positive case so they can receive proper evaluation and/or treatment.
