Chairman Jim Dale called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. with members Don Meats, Fred Rowley, Kenneth Combes and Bob Saueressig present. County Clerk Angie Kirchner, County Counselor Christopher Phelan and Administrative Assistant Donna Berland were present. Coffey County Treasurer Karen Maley, Coffey County Republican Editor Mark Petterson and Cody Haddock were also present.
