COFFEY COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT – ROAD PERMIT

WHEREAS, Owner, herein after termed the Petitioner, requests permission and authority to install, operate and maintain within Coffey County Road Right-of-Way the following describe facilities: \_\_\_\_\_

Said Petitioner agrees to the following conditions and restrictions:

1. Petitioner shall furnish one set of comprehensive plans and specifications or sketches (8 ½" x 11" or larger) of the proposed work.
2. All materials and construction methods within the right-of-way shall be in conformance with the standards of the industry and the County.
3. The Petitioner shall furnish all materials, do all the work, pay all costs and restore said right-of-way to the condition existing prior to the approval of work described on this permit. All work is to be completed within \_\_\_\_ calendar days of the approval date of this permit; otherwise this permit becomes NULL and VOID. An extension of time may be requested in writing.
4. Petitioner agrees that there will be no interference with traffic, unless specifically provided for as a part of this permit. Traffic protection shall be in accordance with the MANUAL OF UNIFORM TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, and traffic control operations shall be the responsibility of the Petitioner.
5. Any sod, shrubs or trees destroyed by this work shall be replaced as directed by the County Engineer.
6. The Petitioner, his successors or assigns shall assume all risk and liability for accidents and damages that may occur to persons or property on account of this work. The Petitioner agrees to indemnify, save and hold harmless Coffey County, from any and all liability that may accrue from any action or inaction by the Petitioner, his agents, assigns or appointees under this Road Permit.
7. Proposed construction approved on this Permit is to be conducted in such a manner as to not interfere with construction or contractor's work on a County project.
8. That the proposed facilities will be located to the satisfaction of the County Engineer or his duly authorized representative. Buried lines shall be **NOT LESS** than 2 feet deep under the roadway and **NOT LESS** than 3 feet deep in the area between the road shoulder and right of way line. Overhead lines shall be **MORE** than 16 feet above the road surface.
9. **All asphalt surfaced roads shall be bored and cased.** Telephone Cables are not required to be cased. All water line crossings shall be cased from flowline of ditch to flowline of ditch for all roads.
10. The Petitioner shall hold harmless Coffey County from any damage claims that might arise from said buried construction or maintenance thereof.
11. That in the event the Board of County Commissioners or County Engineer deems it necessary or proper to make any alteration or improvement along or upon the road or right-of-way, the Petitioner agrees to save Coffey County harmless for any damage to said Petitioner's facilities along or upon said road right-of-way, the Petitioner further agrees that upon notice being served upon him, he will, within \_\_\_\_\_ days, alter or change the location as requested by the Board of County Commissioners or their duly authorized representative without expense to Coffey County.
12. In the event the County Engineer deems it necessary or proper to make any alteration, improvement or routine maintenance along or upon the road right-of-way which is the subject of this Permit, the Petitioner agrees to hold Coffey County harmless for any and all damages or injury to said Petitioner's facilities, whether finished or unfinished, as well as damage or injury to Petitioner's equipment, material, employees, agents or contractors.
13. The Petitioner agrees to notify the County Engineer when the permitted work has been abandoned or retired in place and to be responsible for all costs associated with the removal of abandoned or retired in place work upon the road right-of-way.
14. A check in the amount of \_\_\_\_\_, made payable to Coffey County is hereby deposited with this permit. The Petitioner agrees that in case of failure or refusal to perform the work satisfactorily, the Board of County Commissioners may use all or any part of the deposit to repair or restore the road right of way, and any unused portion will be returned to Petitioner. Utility Companies that regularly perform work on County right of way may post annually a \$1,000.00 performance bond.
15. The Petitioner agrees that this permit may be revoked by the County Commissioners in case the Petitioner fails to locate the facilities properly, or the facilities become a traffic hazard, or are no longer in use.
16. That the Petitioner will notify the County Engineer when work is complete.
17. SPECIAL CONDITIONS: if any, are listed on the back of this Permit.
